Mission

To enable businesses and consumers to identify, locate and authenticate items in our everyday world

Vision

A future where everyday things are part of a connected world ... like raindrops to the sea



What is RAIN RFID?




- RAIN RFID is a wireless technology that connects billions of everyday items to the internet, enabling businesses and consumers to identify, locate, and authenticate each item
- A RAIN RFID solution uses a portal to read and write a tagged item, manages the data and takes action
 - Tags
 - Are either attached or embedded with their items
 - Tagged items store and send information
 - Thousands can be identified simultaneously and do not have to be visible

Portals

- Have attached antenna(s) for either short or long range communication
- Can be small and portable, or larger and installed, or embedded in other devices
- Software applications
 - Identify Locate Authenticate
 - Use the tags and portals to create, collect and use the item's data locally, or on a server, or on a cloud
 - Authentication starts with the origin and history of each item






RAIN – enabling the IoT
